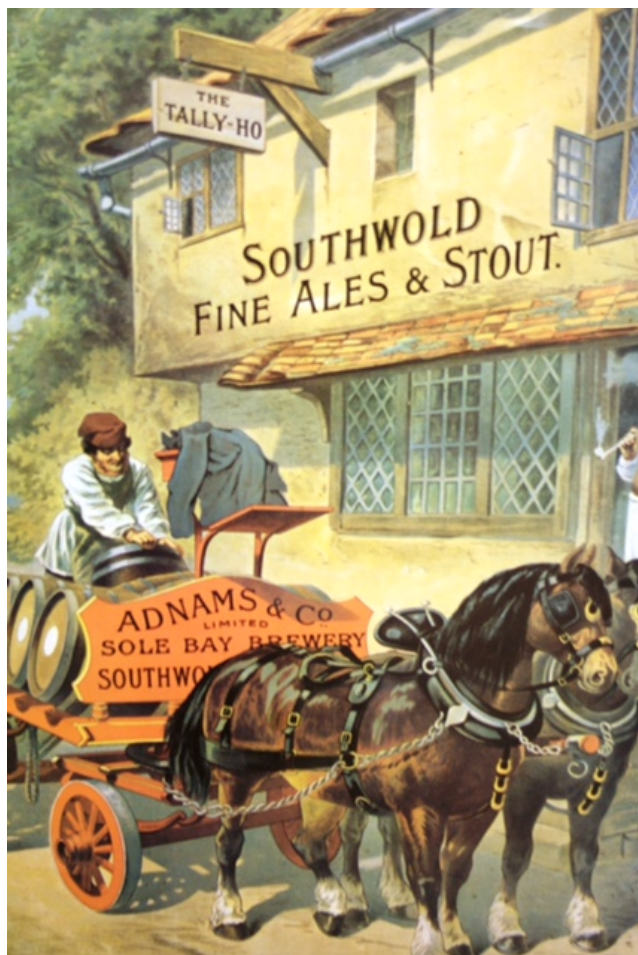
The Auction Centre is open for business 8.30am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday and between 9am and 12noon on Saturday and at other times when we have a special sale.
